



# TOWN OF WRIGHTSVILLE BEACH SANITATION NEWSLETTER

The Sanitation division of Public Works operates 7 days per week with a staff of 7 people. This division removes about 5,000 tons of trash annually. Most of the trash collected is residential, beach, and commercial waste. Other materials collected include: fee based yard debris and miscellaneous bulk items. In addition to trash removal, the Sanitation Division provides litter pickup throughout the Town.

<p>Our town crews work very hard at keeping our beach strand clean and free of trash. Trash barrels are emptied on routine basis with extra pickups during busy seasonal holidays. If you spot trash or debris that needs to be disposed of, you can help out too. There are many trash barrels along our strand and streets. THERE IS NO ACTIVE LANDFILL OR DROP OFF SITE IN WRIGHTSVILLE BEACH.</p> <p><b>NHC HazWagon</b></p> <p>The Town of Wrightsville Beach Public Works will <b>not</b> pick up household hazardous waste such as mercury thermostats and thermometers, CFL bulbs, batteries, household cleaners, aerosols, acids, caustic materials, cooking oils, motor oils and filters, antifreeze, paint, smoke detectors, sharps (needles), and electronics. New Hanover County has a mobile Household Hazardous Waste unit. Residents can bring toxic materials and electronics to the HazWagon free of charge on <b>Wednesdays between 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM</b>, in the Farmer's Market field (adjacent to Town Hall). <p><b>YARD DEBRIS</b></p> <p>The Town uses a wood chipper to process yard debris. No trash may commingle with the wood chips. Plastic bags cannot go through the chipper. Yard debris in plastic bags will not be picked up. Yard debris may not be placed in any containment other than paper bags.</p>	Appliances	\$25.00 per appliance

**Items such as yard debris, furniture, miscellaneous bulky items and appliances are collected at an additional charge when placed at the curb.**

**Any and all non-household waste placed outside the cart will be billed appropriately. Items are to be placed within 3 feet of the curb or the edge of streets having no curbing.**

**TRASH CARTS:** Town ordinances require a minimum of one trash cart per dwelling unit, (additional carts may be requested at an additional fee). Once delivered, the trash carts become the responsibility of the property owner. Lost or damaged carts are replaced at a cost of \$80 per cart to the owner. Trash carts shall be put out for collection before 7:00 am on the day of collection and must be brought back parallel to the front of the house by that evening. Rollout carts shall remain property of the Town of Wrightsville Beach.

**Sanitation fees provide for the cleanup and trash disposal for all areas of the Island, including the beach strand.**
