TOWN OF WRIGHTSVILLE BEACH ANNOUNCES NEW TENANT FOR HISTORIC EWING-BORDEAUX COTTAGE

WRIGHTSVILLE BEACH, NC – The [Town of Wrightsville Beach](#) entered a lease agreement with the [Harbor Island Garden Club](#) for the historic Ewing-Bordeaux Cottage beginning September 2024. As part of the agreement, the Harbor Island Garden Club will take over the entirety of the cottage through June 2025.

“For more than 70 years, the Harbor Island Garden Club has worked to connect and improve our community. We believe the club will be a great tenant for the Ewing-Bordeaux Cottage, and we are excited to see how they use the space to serve our community,” said Tony Wilson, acting town manager of the Town of Wrightsville Beach.

The Harbor Island Garden Club has been an integral part of the Wrightsville Beach community since its establishment in 1952. Together with the town, the award-winning club focuses on community education, beautification, and environmental improvements throughout Wrightsville Beach.

“We are excited about this moment in our club’s history, and what it means for the future,” said Vicki Dull, president of the Harbor Island Garden Club. “The cottage will serve as a home base for our club, and provide space for us to continue our efforts to support Wrightsville Beach. We look forward to welcoming the community to our new space in the coming months.”

Constructed in 1924, the Ewing-Bordeaux Cottage is a locally-recognized landmark and part of the town’s historic square. Built as a summer-only beach cottage, it was one of six that survived the Great Fire of 1934. Originally located at 405 North Lumina Ave., in January 2018 the structure was moved to its current home at 303 West Salisbury St.
